

OCTOBER 30, 2015

ssues guidance to agencies on Fiscal Year 2015 – 2016 FISMA

AUGUST 3, 2015

leases results of the 30-Day Cybersecurity Sprint, showing agencies ncreased their use of strong authentication

OCTOBER 21, 2015

oposes for the first time in 15 years revisions to Circular A-130, Managing formation as a Strategic Resource

OCTOBER 16, 2015

Directs all civilian agencies to purchase aptops and desktops through **existing** "best value" government-wide contracts

OCTOBER 30, 2015

Takes the results of the 30-Day Cybersecurity Sprint and creates the Cybersecurity Strategy and Implementation Plan ("CSIP")
